Encounters: An Evening of Drama, Dance & Devotion

Over 200 attended to participate in an event with the sole purpose of encountering the God of Israel. Three original skits written by Juanita Weiss were accompanied by dance and a moderator centering devotionally on each theme. In "The Ball of Fire" Hirah (Elvie Seidel) and Asher (Eric Robinson), two Israelite slaves who have left Egypt, react differently to the pillar of fire that follows them in the wilderness. In "The Wilderness" Milcah (Laura Storm), Rivka (Christina Rarick), Hoglah (Arlene Davis) struggle with the prospect of entering the Promised Land.

In "A Desperate Woman, a magnificent, emotion-packed drama was brilliantly performed by the duo of (Shawna Starke), a Canaanite mother of a demon-possessed daughter, (Aviana Starke). As Shawna displays such raw emotion of a woman who

is kneeling before her only Hope, who seems not to want to help her, we find ourselves pleading with her on her daughter's behalf, and although the daughter is less seen, her impact on the scene through piercing screams is penetrating.

Amazing choreography from She'rit Dancers of Beth Messiah Synagogue and the Kingdom World Outreach Dancers further brought the theme from each skit to life. Daniel Rosenfarb, Chris Mitchell, and Marcia Clarke, respectively, brought powerful, thematic, riveting, and anointed messages after each dance. Many were moved and provoked into deep contemplation by this anointed endeavor.

have been led to bring young musicians into the nursing home to provide music therapy to the residents.

WM is honored to present its first book scholarship in the amount of \$100 to Lili Niezankiewicz (pic 1), the first teen to serve in this capacity and to support Weiss Ministries in several other events and productions. "I had such an amazing time," she said. "It was I who was blessed the most from this outreach. It blessed me to see Godly women who are so strong in their faith."

Experiencing Him: A Night of Worship

November 9th marked a new milestone for WM with a presentation of "Experiencing Him: A Night of Worship." The goal of the ministry is to bridge the gaps between diverse social groups, denominations, races, ages, and share the Hebraic message of love and hope. "The Night of Worship" was a snapshot of this goal. The event, held at Beth Messiah Synagogue in Norfolk, was an



anointed evening of music which included Latin worship, contemporary Christian, modern Gospel, Messianic worship, Ethiopian worship and dance, canting of Hebrew Scripture, rap, and a "stand-to-your-feet" performance by Corine Tyler and her son Allen Clark of the Gospel great, "Stay Under the Blood." Sprinkled amid the musical sounds of the evening were several types of interpretive dance, mime, and two oral pieces. Original spoken word poetry by Natasha Bachar was particularly moving. Co-founder of WM, Juanita Weiss presented an oral interpretation of Psalm 139 that stirred the soul to joy. Min. Chris Mitchell from Kingdom World Outreach Center beautifully wove each performance together as master of ceremonies. The night was a tremendous success, due not only to the wonderful and anointed performances, but from the great enthusiasm from those who came to worship! 

WM Hosts Domestic Violence Awareness Workshop

WM partnered with Garden of Hope nonprofit agency at a round-table workshop to promote Domestic Violence Awareness. Four Thursday evenings in October, WM hosted 25 individuals who sought more information on identifying victims of domestic violence and how to minister to them.

In the shocking initial workshop, the group was introduced to two sisters via videotape, both victims, but each choosing a different path for their lives. In subsequent meetings, participants discussed the differences between healthy and unhealthy relationships and were given tools to help in identifying them. Each session was led by Carla Galloway. Some of the participants were able to tell their own personal stories of violence, and through activities, were able to see the legal ramifications of domestic abuse. All came away with greater tools to help these members of our community often overlooked. All concluded that the workshop was unforgettable and inspiring.
